Stonehill & Taylor Embarks on Four High Profile Hotel Projects Across the US

New York (November 2014) – Building on its portfolio of design-forward destinations, Stonehill & Taylor was awarded three new hotel properties in New York City, San Francisco and Virginia Beach.

With Stonehill & Taylor at the helm the historic **Powell Hotel** in San Francisco will be transformed into an independent boutique property geared towards young, hip professionals. The firm is responsible for the interior design of the 150-room hotel, slated for completion in Summer 2015.

The Stonehill & Taylor interior design team is renovating the legendary luxury hotel, **The Cavalier** in Virginia Beach. Their work will return the property to its former glory, when the historic hotel hosted a long line of American presidents and dignitaries. The design will mix a contemporary understanding of luxury with a feeling unique to the era of The Cavalier's heyday. It is scheduled to open in late 2015.

The firm was awarded the role of architect for the new **Dream Hotel Times Square**. The ambitious building project at 40th Street and 7th Ave will transform the site of the old Parsons School of Design building into a newly built hotel with a sculptural silhouette and unique design elements. A 2017 opening is planned.

Stonehill & Taylor is currently working as the interior architect for the hotel portion of a new 1,000-foot-tall mixed-use building in the center of Related Companies' **Hudson Yards** megaproject. The hotel will be the first property and flagship for a new hotel brand focused on health and fitness, and will feature a multi-level sky-lobby with a large roof terrace, a meeting complex, and a signature dining experience. This project is slated to open in 2018.
